- **Accepted online August 1 - Sept. 16, 2018**

## 2018 OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to all home brewers, who are residents of the State of California.

**1.** The Beer Judging Certification Program (BJCP) and American Home brewer's Association (AHA) sanction this competition.

**2.** 2015 BJCP style guidelines will be used for the judging and judges will be a combination of BJCP certified judges, professional brewers and "novice" judges who will be guided by BJCP protocol.

**3.** Entries MUST NOT be made in a commercial brewing establishment.

**4.** Entries are limited to 8 per person.

**5.** Three bottles of beer are required for each entry.

**6.** Bottles must be 11 -14 oz. brown or green bottles with no identifiable markings other than Bottle ID label affixed with rubber band.

**7.** No refunds of entry fees will be allowed.

**Prizes:** Prize rosettes will be awarded to first, second and third place winners in each class. Best of Show winner will also receive a plaque

## HOW DO I ENTER?

**1.** You need to register as a new exhibitor using our secure online entry system. Those that entered last year must also sign in as a new exhibitor.)

**2.** Select the department: Homebrew

**3.** Create/add your home brew entries to your shopping cart.

**4.** During check out you will pay for entries in your shopping cart with a credit card and print out your receipt.

**5.** Print & fill out bottle identification label template. Use a rubber band to affix one label to each of your 3 beer bottles per entry.

**6.** Deliver your home brew entries to **The Beverage People**.
